

Fife Council Property Flood Resilience (PFR) Grant Application

The scheme will help owners improve the flood resilience of their property by claiming up to **£5,000 per property** to fund measures which improve their flood resilience.

This could be in the form of Air Brick Covers, Flood Doors, Non Return Valves, etc.

The Process

1. Complete and submit your application form
2. We will assess your application, notify, and request for supporting information
3. We assess your supporting information to determine the level of grant funding and issue terms and conditions
4. You must return signed terms and conditions
5. Grant approved and payment issued
6. Fife Council will then inspect works upon completion

Supporting information to be provided during application process.

1. Evidence that your property has experienced flooding or is at risk of flooding. For example pictures.
2. Complete the Scottish Flood Forum Property Protection Advice form (online) or arrange an individual property assessment via the Scottish Flood Forum and obtain Property Flood Assessment Report
3. Consider any planning conditions (Conservation Area and Listed Building)
4. Obtain a works quotation from a contractor or Material costs, if you wish to install yourself
5. Estimated completion date to complete the Works
