

Social Work said I'm an adult at risk. What happens next?



Social Work will visit you and show identification.
Their identification will be their Fife Council badge.



Social Work will explain why they are there.
They will give you a letter that explains this too.



They will want to hear what you think.
They will ask questions about what has happened.



Social Work may need to see where you live,
depending on what has happened.



They may ask anyone else in the house questions
as well.

This is called an Investigation.

How will Social Work stop the harm from happening?



This could be:

- Telling someone to stay away from you



- Helping the people close to you understand how to support you better



- Giving you advice about how to keep yourself safe.
